
STUDENT RULES

1. Students **must pay** medical bills and **for any damage** caused in the host family home, in school or while engaged in social or other activities.
2. Students must arrange their own travel insurance before arrival in Ireland against any expenses which might arise due to accident or illness, together with loss of luggage, personal effects and money.
3. You must carry your school identity card with you at all times.
4. Students must pay for replacement bus/rail travel passes.
5. Students must return to the host family home no later than 21:30 each evening. On nights when students attend Bray Language School evening activities the time is 22:00. [**This rule does not apply if you are out with your host family.**]
6. When going out in the evening or at weekends, you must inform your host family where you are going and with whom.
7. Your host parents have been instructed not to give you a key to the family home. Under no circumstances are you to ask for one, nor should you request that a key be left out for you. In some circumstances a key may be given to students by prior arrangement with the school.
8. A suitable call card should be used for calls made on the host family telephone. Please ask for permission before using the telephone or internet connection.
9. Smoking is not allowed at any time either in school or in the host family home.
10. The possession or consumption of alcohol is strictly forbidden.
11. The possession or consumption of illegal substances at any time is strictly forbidden.
12. Students are asked to take care while walking on footpaths and crossing roads. **Pedestrian crossings must be used.** Please remember that the traffic travels on the left hand side of the road in Ireland. Remember to look both ways before crossing.
14. You should not carry large sums of money or valuables with you.
15. In Ireland there is a queue system when using public transport. Please ensure that you observe this custom.
16. Students may not attend discos etc. unless they are organised by Bray Language Centre for their particular group.
17. Students are not allowed to go outside Bray at any time unless accompanied by their group leader.
18. Chewing gum is not allowed in school.
