
STUDENT RULES

1. Students must pay medical bills or for any damage caused in the host family home, in school or while engaged in social or other activities.
2. Students must arrange their own travel insurance before arrival in Ireland against any expenses which might arise due to accident or illness, together with loss of luggage, personal effects and money.
3. You must carry your school contact card with you at all times.
4. Students must be home at 10.30 each night. On nights when students attend Bray Language Centre evening activities the time is 11.00 . **[This rule does not apply if you are out with your host family.]**
5. When going out in the evening or at weekends, you must inform your host family where you are going and with whom.
6. Your host parents have been instructed not to give you a key to the family home. Under no circumstances are you to ask for one nor should you request that a key be left out for you. **[This rule does not apply to students 18 years of age or older. Also, if special circumstances apply a key may be given at the discretion of the host family]**
7. The cost of local calls should be paid for immediately. Any calls to your home country should be made using the relevant 1800 number so that they are on a " reverse charge" basis, or you should use a phone card. i.e. France 1800 5510033, Spain 1800 550034, Italy 1800 55 0039, Austria 1800 550043
8. Smoking is not allowed at any time either in school or in the home of the host family.
9. The possession or consumption of alcohol is strictly forbidden for students under the age of eighteen.
10. The possession or consumption of illegal substances at any time is strictly forbidden.
11. Hitch-hiking is strictly forbidden.
12. All text books must be returned in acceptable condition on the last day of class. A charge will apply for damaged or lost books.
13. You should not carry large sums of money or valuables with you.
14. In Ireland there is a queue system when using public transport. Please ensure that you observe this custom.
15. Students may not attend discos etc. unless they are organised by Bray Language Centre for their particular group.
16. Students are not allowed to go to Dublin at any time unless accompanied by their group leader.

These rules have been drawn up to help avoid any misunderstandings that may arise when visiting a foreign country. We are sure that if they are observed, your stay will be all the more enjoyable.
